Procedures for submitting scores

- 1 Player games are required, so we know the score is yours.
- After the game completes, take a photo including these three things:
 - Your face
 - The tournament sticker
 - Your score
- Submit the photo by posting it in the Facebook event page for Silverball Cyclorama.
- Write your score legibly on this score sheet.
- Have another tournament player initial each score to verify.

Rules

- Players are eligible for B Division if they are unranked or ranked below 3000 in the IFPA rankings. All others are relegated to A Division
- Queue in for every game you play by writing your name on the sign in sheet located by the game, even if no one is currently playing it. Cross your name off when you are done. This will help keep things in order.
- **Play each game once and only once.**
- Extra balls should be turned off, but if they are not, **do not play them.** If you are awarded one, “plunge” it by pulling the plunger back and letting it go. **Do not hit the flippers.** You may try to hit a skill shot, provided it does not involve hitting the flippers.
- In the event of a stuck ball, game malfunction, or any other problem, please alert a tournament volunteer and we will assist you as best we can.
- Due to the spread out nature of this event, if a machine is deemed to be unplayable at any point during the tournament by tournament officials, scores for that game will not count, regardless of how many people have played it.
- “Bangbacks”, “Deathsaves”, or any other egregious abuse of the machine will result in a 0 score for that game. Two such instances will result in disqualification from the tournament.

Scoring

- **Scoring will be based on a 100 pt system by A/B division, as explained below**
 - 1st place: 100
 - 2nd place: 90
 - 3rd place:85
 - 4th place: 84
 - 5th place: 83...
- Points awarded for all games will be added up to determine a player’s final score. Players (in A Division only) with the highest point totals will compete in the playoffs. Prizes for B division will be awarded after scores are tallied and without playoffs.

Playoffs (A Division Only) @ CBW

- Top 6 players in A division will move into the playoffs, with the 1st and 2nd place qualifiers moving directly into the finals. Qualifiers 3 through 6 will play two games. Scoring will be a 4,2,1,0 system with a tie breaker for moving on if needed. The finals will be played on the same two games, with tie breakers if needed.

Tournament Officials have final discretion over disputes. Please alert us of any issues so they can be addressed.
